Many refrain from purchasing poultry that was used for kaparos and sent back to the slaughter house. Therefore, they don't purchase KJ/Kiryas Joel poultry from Rosh Hashonah till a week after Succos. BirdsBoro poultry does not take any kaparos poultry to be used in their plant. Therefore many will insist on using only the Birdsboro poultry.

Schwartz's and Mehadrin Kaparos do not send their kaparos to Kiryas Joel/KJ. They shecht their kaparos in Lakewood and give it to Anyim locally as the Halacha specifies.

Double U kashrus (Yehuda Shain) recommended items for Bnei Torah: **Vegetable & Canola oils**- only from USA or Canada and with OU (including Chefs Quality, Restaurant Depot, Chefs pride). **Tomato juice**- Sacramento. **Duck sauce, horseradish, ketchup, honey mustard, etc.**- Golds brand. **Canned tomato products (Peeled tomatoes, crushed tomatoes, tomato puree, etc.)**- Red Gold Company, and Tutturoso brand. **Coconut oil**- Simply Nature-cold pressed virgin oil. **Peanut butter**- Skippy's, and other OU (USA).

Mayonnaise- Roberts, Hellman's USA, but not with olive oil. **Dr. Pepper- is not recommended**, at this time. **Fish sticks are made with pollack or hake and are infested fish.**

Poultry- Birdsboro, KJ/Kiryas Joel, Franklins/Pelleh, Dave Elliot, Meyuchad. **Meat**- Solomon's, Fishel's, Birdsboro, Bingo's brand, Meal Mart/Alle from N. America, West Side distributors. Do **not use the Agri, Aarons, Tevya's, Rubaskin, KJ or the Baltimore Hashgochas.**

Beit-Yosef "Shay'ish" is a scandal in the making, and a fraud. The current Bet-Yosef situation is far from acceptable for Sfaridim, as they are being "sketched", except the Solomons, Fishel's and Birdsboro's Bet Yosef which is reliable.

Raisins, strawberries, blueberries, raspberries (fresh, frozen or dried), sun-dried tomatoes, quinoa, figs (fresh or dried), and black eyed peas are all infested and can't be checked. Strawberries are permissible if peeled. **Pre-washed vegetables, herbs, etc.**- Only Positive/ Kosher Garden brands, or with Ari Green sticker. No Andy Boy even with hashgocha. **Corn on the cob fresh & (frozen was blanched) are all infested.** Raw corn must be de-kernelized and washed prior to cooking. **Garlic**- has mites on the outside. Peel over paper (to avoid mites on the counter etc.) and wash the garlic and knife well. **ALL Nori sheets used for Sushi**- heavily infested, use rice or soy paper.

Dry herbs or spices - any with OU, Pereg. **Fresh Salmon**- Farmed and with skin. **Canned salmon**- infested. **Candies**- without confectionary glaze. **Fish heads**- cleaned @ Fishing line, or whole smoked white fish - remove tail, the rest is "head". **Stuffed cabbage**- Remove core by cutting it out, remove outer leaf, freeze for 48 hours, thaw, rinse both sides of each leaf under cool water then you may use it as is.

Orange juice- has insects that must filtered out with a 100-mesh filter. Filters are available for \$10.00 @1140 Forest Ave. (corner Carey St.) Lakewood (732-364-8046). **Wines**- Kedem NY, Rashi Bayonne NJ, Carmel, Schwartz, Armon, Yayin. **Olive oil, including extra virgin**- only with mashgiach present type of hashgocha.

Alert: Due to many kashrus issues and concerns present at all caterers and restaurants, etc., it's a must to hire your own qualified mashgiach to be present during all of the cooking. Sadly, some Hashgochas refuse to allow your own qualified mashgiach; they are concerned he'll realize serious concerns and issues present.

Use "Jute" twine to tie down your schach, it's a plant.

One should be makpid on pas-visroel in Aseres-Yimei-Teshuva and every Shabbos and Yom Tov as well.
